The game of mini golf consists of playing a ball from the tee into the hole by a stroke or successive strokes in accordance with the rules. The Hawaiian Rumble Ladies League is a "for fun" league, and participants should conduct themselves accordingly.

A. Registration

- 1. The league is limited to the first 40 participants registered.
- 2. Registration includes payment of \$40 to the League Coordinator and submitting the signed rules document.

B. Rules of Stroke Play

- 1. The tee is designated by the yellow lines or dots at each hole. Balls may be placed on the tee line or behind the tee line.
- 2. The competitor who plays the stipulated round is playing the game of the week.
- 3. 5 stroke limit per hole.
- 4. One stroke penalty if:
 - a). Ball jumps fairway play next shot from spot where ball jumped fairway.
 - b). Ball is snagged in an obstacle free ball and play from that spot, not nearer the hole.
- 5. Ball may be moved the length of the scorecard from a rail or hazard without a penalty.
- 6. After members of party reach putting green, the one nearest the hole will putt first and continue to putt until ball is in cup. Do not take turns on the putting greens.
- 7. If the ball rolls down a hill past the tee box, player may return the ball to the tee without penalty and begin again.

C. Equipment

1. Clubs: Participants may use a regulation putter or the putter provided by Hawaiian Rumble.

2. The Ball: Participants may use regulation golf balls, balls sold at Hawaiian Rumble, or balls provided by Hawaiian Rumble.

D. Player's Responsibilities

- 1. Competitors shall remain in the group/foursome to which they have been assigned during check-in. Each participant is playing their individual score.
- 2. Players should check their score after each hole for accuracy. Scores may not be altered once the scorecard has been turned in. Turn in one scorecard per group. All players should sign the score card, and it must be turned in to the site supervisor or disqualification results.
- 3. There will be no handicapping of scores.
- 4. Players should not unduly delay play.
- 5. The playing of practice strokes during the play of a hole or between holes is forbidden. A practice swing is not a stroke unless the ball is hit.
- 6. The number of strokes a player has taken shall include penalty strokes incurred.

E. Prizes

- 1. Each week a different game will be chosen by drawing. The chosen game will not be repeated during the course of the league. Participants will not know the game that they are playing until after the round, so participants are encouraged to do their best. Players can view the game drawn after completion of their round. Examples of games include:
 - a). Most hole-in-ones
 - b). Low score
 - c). High Score
 - d). Low score on holes 2, 8, 13, 16
 - e). Low score for holes 3, 6, 11, 15
 - f). Most 4's in a round
 - g). Most 2's in a round
 - h). Surprise team event...Foursome with lowest score divides prize.
- 2. Three places will win prize money. First place will receive 1/2 of the total prize pool. Second place will receive 3/8 of the prize pool. Third place will receive 1/8 of the prize pool. For example, if the prize pool is \$200, first place receives \$100. Second place receives \$75. Third place receives \$25. The prize pool will be based on the number of participants.

3. On the last week of play, the participants with the lowest number of strokes for the season wins prizes.

E. Prizes (Continued)

- 4. Prizes will be announced via email and paid the following week. Hence, participants may leave after the conclusion of their round.
- 5. If the number of planned rain dates is exceeded, the prize pool for any missed days of play will be rolled into the final week's prize (the low score for the season).
- 6. If a tie occurs, the tie will be broken by low cumulative score counting from the 18th hole backward.
